## Bolivia

Partnering with key Bolivian national believers, we work closely with leaders of the OEN churches in Guayaramerin and Santa Cruz who share our passion of reaching remote indigenous groups.

> Select volunteers in-country, as well as from the US, Canada, and Europe provide medical care, discipleship training, and construction labor for outreaches to the Amazon jungle and beyond.



12 Bolivian volunteers repaired and renovated "El Misionero," the riverboat used for medical missions to remote villages along the Amazon River in January and February 2020.

## Youth Outreach Bolivia

- Several teens were saved and baptized!
- Many more teens dedicated their lives to serving the Lord.







**90** Bolivian national believers reached out to the neighboring villages for a youth rally.

Youth from 21 villages were transported to the village of Baures for the teaching.



## Inspiracion Radio Outreach

Broadcasts 24 hours a day, seven days a week, sending Christian music, teaching, and discipleship to unreached people groups in remote areas of Bolivia and Brazil!

**200** Galcon radios were distributed to the Pacaas Novas Indian village.

extensive Bible training in Panama. Due to COVID-19, their stay was extended for 10 months.


Rama teachers were discipled weekly via phone to equip them to teach Creation to Christ Chronological content to the other zillagers.

# Papua New Guinea

In 2020, Friends In Action supported dozens of missionary partners to reach more than

3,200

Wewak villagers and tribes with the Gospel.

## Assisting Missionaries

FIA team leaders provided mechanical repair, timber, and construction projects to help dozens of missionaries reach further into unreached areas of PNG.



#### **Life-Skills Training**



FIA's team leaders train national workers to run the sawmill providing materials to assist missionaries in more remote areas. They also learn small machinery repair, carpentry, and other construction skills. Over time, the nationals have taken over much of the work themselves, becoming missionaries to their own people-the very hands and feet of Christ. Some of the men who attend the daily devotions held before work share the Gospel with their own families and villagers!

## **Student Sponsorship**

**FIA invests in the education** of Papua New Guinea's next generation of pastors and teachers by providing a percentage of the bus and school fees for our national workers' children. In 2020, we were excited to see 16 more children receive a quality education!


## Vanuatu

In 2020, Friends In Action provided cyclone relief and progress toward a water project for

3,500

NiVan villagers in remote regions of Vanuatu.

#### **Cyclone Relief – Recovery Bundles**



Thanks to generous FIA donors many villagers were able to begin rebuilding after **Cyclone Harold leveled their** communities in April 2020. Hundreds of villagers used the nails, hammers, handsaws, shovels, bush knives, file mills, tape measures, and ropes to build new homes. The tools were then passed to other villages to continue efforts in Suranda Village, Vunikarakara Village, Luganville Bible Church, Karia Community, and Mataloi Village.

## Water Project

A supply truck was purchased and retrofitting has begun to prepare for shipment in 2021.

Pastor Gaby continues to cultivate relationships with the 30 chiefs who agree to open their villages to the Gospel upon completion of the project.



#### **Cyclone Relief Food**

Suranda, Karia, and Mataloi.





# West Africa


In 2020, Friends In Action relocated The Water of Life ministry to a new region of West Africa and impacted

1,000+ refugees with clean water.

#### **Well Drilling**

Local FIA representation was approached by government authorities to drill

wells to assist refugees fleeing atrocities in the northern regions of the country providing drinking water for close to 1,000 people.


